Conduct of 18-Day Campaign to End Violence Against Women and Children (end VAWC)

Advocacy Tokens

I. Background

Violence against women (VAW) is one of the country's pervasive social problems. It is considered to be a grave violation of women's rights and fundamental freedoms. The United Nations (UN) Declaration on the Elimination of Violence against Women defines it as "one of the crucial social mechanisms by which women are forced into a subordinate position compare with men." Global estimates by the World Health Organization (WHO) indicate that about 1 in 3 or over 800 million women worldwide have experienced either physical and/or sexual violence from intimate partner or non-partner in their lifetime. While in the Philippines, the National Demographic Health Survey 2017 showed that 1 in 4 Filipino women, aged 15-49 has experienced physical, emotional or sexual violence from their husband or partner.

Amnesty International often referred to VAW as "hidden epidemic" which spreads through social, cultural, and ethnic areas. All forms of violence and the threats of violence can be experienced by every woman of any age, skin color, gender identity, ethnicity, religion, disabilities, economic, and social status.


Throughout the years, VAW emerged to be one of the country's prevalent social issue and various measures and mechanisms have been employed and implemented to address it. One of which is the **18-Day Campaign to End VAW**, an advocacy campaign that is observed annually from November 25 to December 12 as mandated by Proclamation 1172 s. 2006

The 18-Day Campaign to End VAW supports the Philippine government's goal of protecting the human rights of women and girls by upholding its commitment to address all forms of gender-based violence as enshrined in the 1987 Constitution. By virtue of Republic Act 10398 or the Act declaring November 25 of every year as the National Consciousness Day for the Elimination of VAWC, government agencies are mandated to raise awareness on the problem of violence and the elimination of all forms of violence against women and girls.

The purchase of the advocacy tokens for NPC employees composed of the following items will be used in observance of 18-Day Campaign to End VAW.
