TERMS OF REFERENCE (TOR)

I. Project Title:

DPO ACE Level 2 AVP

II. Background:

The National Privacy Commission (NPC) is a government agency mandated to administer and implement the Data Privacy Act of 2012 (DPA), and to monitor and ensure compliance of entities that process personal data with the standards set for data protection in government and the private sector. One of the mandates of NPC is to undertake necessary or appropriate efforts to encourage and assist Personal Information Controllers in achieving substantial compliance with the DPA. In this connection, the Commission initiated the PHIL-DPO Development Program to capacitate and assist the registered Data Protection Officers (DPOs) of Personal Information Controllers in their journey towards compliance with the requirements of the DPA.

The PHIL-DPO Development Program is a training program that aims to educate and/or capacitate a Data Protection Officer (DPO) on steps required to implement DPA compliance in their respective organizations. The Program is divided into two (2) Levels and is conducted in a classroom setting. NPC has been providing Level 1 of the Program in various locations across the Philippines to increase the number of certified DPOs across the nation. This has raised a great demand from DPOs across different regions to participate in the Program and be certified by the NPC. Unfortunately, due to budgetary and scheduling restrictions, not all DPOs could be accommodated as participants in the scheduled events of the NPC relative to the Program.

III. Objectives:

The aim of this project is to produce an animated Audio-Visual Presentation (AVP) that will be used as online training material for the DPO ACE Certification Level 2 Training Program. This is intended to supplement the facilitation of the DPO ACE LEVEL 2 Training Program and enable more participants to engage in the Training Program in the transition to the new normal brought about by the COVID-19 pandemic. This project also aims to increase the number of the Certified Data Protection Officers by the NPC with a higher level of knowledge and understanding and to widen the reach of the DPO ACE Training Program beyond the confines of a classroom setting and extend its coverage nationwide through the uploading of the AVP presentations online.



IV. Scope of Work

The deliverables of this project are as follows:

- 1. Sequence Outline, English pre-production script, and storyboard per Level 2 AVP module. Each script should have a continuity portion (Intro and Outro). The continuity and body of the script must be consecutively voiced by a male and female talent; alternating per module (i.e., in Module 8, the continuity is to be voiced by a female, while the body by a male. In Module 9, the order is reversed, and so on).
- 2. Edited voice over file per module utilizing one (1) male and one (1) female voice talent/s.
- 3. Seven (7) post-produced animated AVPs, one per each module of the DPO ACE Program in MP4 format. The content of the AVPs for animation shall be provided by the members of the PHIL-DPO Development Program.
- 4. Each AVP should not exceed twenty-five (25) minutes.
- 5. All 7 animated AVPs per module should have closed captions (subtitles) accompanying the voice-over file.
- 6. Completed and approved AVPs per module must be stored in one (1) external hard drive in .mp4 file format.
- 7. All AVPs must be finished and reviewed by the Commission within six (6) months upon signing of the contract between the parties but should not go beyond 30 June 2021.



V. <u>Eligibility Requirements:</u>

- Must be Filipino-owned, operated and a legally registered video production company under Philippine laws.
- Must be duly registered with the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS).
- Must have a minimum of 2 years commercial experience in the field of video production.
- Must be able to propose a highly unique, creative concept of presenting Level 2 of the DPO ACE Certification Training Program.
- Must have a breed of staff adept with the latest tools on video production, which includes a scriptwriter and voice over talents.
- Must have serviced a wide range of clients, with preference to those having produced online learning/instructional videos.

VI. Legal and Technical Eligibility Requirements:

VII. <u>Delivery Date</u>

Within six (6) moths from Work Order but shall not be beyond June 30, 2021.

VIII. Schedule of Payment

With the given percentage of payment upon completion of deliverables, the proposed total budget for the procurement of the DPO ACE Level 2 AVP should not exceed \$\mathbb{P}800,000.00.

Payment shall only be made upon the issuance of an Inspection and Acceptance Certificate by the Inspection and Acceptance Committee of the Commission upon the recommendation of the end-user.
