#### TERMS OF REFERENCE Disinfection Services

#### 1. COVERAGE

The Philippines was placed under a state of public emergency under Proclamation No. 922 to arrest the spread of novel coronavirus infections after local transmission is confirmed. Modified work arrangement in government was also implemented to align with the community quarantine rules issued by the Inter-Agency Task Force on Managing of Emerging Infectious Disease (IATF). Under CSC Resolution No. 2000912 promulgated on 14 October 2020, and circularized via CSC Memorandum Circular No. 18, s. 2020, agencies located in areas under Enhanced Community Quarantine (ECQ) and Modified Enhanced Community Quarantine (MECQ) shall adopt work-from-home arrangement, while skeleton workforce may be allowed unless a different operational capacity is provided in agencies providing essential or critical services. With the return of employees to offices, the premises must be free from viruses, and thus conduct of disinfection is necessary in compliance to the health and safety protocols recommended by the IATF and Department of Health (DOH).

The project covers disinfection services of the National Privacy Commission (NPC) Office located at the 5<sup>th</sup> floor, Delegation Bldg., Philippine International Convention Center, Pasay City.

### 2. DURATION

The program will cover disinfection treatments twice a month for one (1) year.

3. Approved Budget for the Contract: P 360,000.00

#### 4. SCOPE OF WORK

The CONTRACTOR shall provide the NPC the following services as stipulated:

- 4.1 Ensure that all areas are sanitized with disinfectant to kill any viruses and bacteria
- 4.2 Prioritize disinfecting frequently touched surfaces such as tables, doorknobs, light switches, countertops, handles, desks, phones, keyboards, toilet, faucet and sinks.
- 4.3 The disinfection team should ensure cleanliness of the area treated
- 4.4 Procedures of treatment:
- 4.4.1 Before disinfection
  - Cover all electrical outlets behind computers and machines in offices and other premises
  - No employees should be in the area being disinfected

- All windows and doors are to remain close for at least two (2) hours before reentry.
- 4.4.2 During disinfection
  - Technicians should be in complete PPE
  - All disinfectants and machines to be used are complete and ready
- 4.4.3 After disinfection
  - Technician should make certain that all areas are thoroughly disinfected
  - Treatment report shall be acknowledged upon completion of treatment

#### 5. WARRANTY/ GUARANTY

- 5.1 Contractor shall conduct treatments twice a month and ensure that all areas are disinfected;
- 5.2 The disinfectants to be used must be approved by the Food Drug Administration (FDA).
- 5.3 The contractor shall provide all the materials/chemicals and other supplies needed for the disinfection program;

#### 6. TERMS OF PAYMENT

Billing shall be made monthly upon submission of Treatment Service Report and Statement of Account.

#### 7. The Contractor Qualification

- 7.1 The Contractor shall submit the latest business permit showing that offers disinfection services.
- 7.2 The Contractor shall submit its PhilGEPS Registration Number.
- 7.3 The Contractor Shall provide Certified disinfection chemicals that is approved by the Food Drug Administration (FDA).
