SUBJECT: Engagement of Services for the Conduct of Privacy Survey National Privacy Commission (NPC)

The National Privacy Commission Bids and Awards Committee (NPC-BAC), hereby issues this Supplemental/Bid Bulletin to guide the bidders with regard to the technical specifications for the engagement of services for the **Conduct of Privacy Survey**, to wit:

CLARIFICATION/ QUESTION	ADDENDUM/AMENDMENT/ ANSWER
Will the result of the previous Privacy Survey be compared to the new results that will be generated from this project?	Yes, the service provider is expected to conduct a comparative study of the results of the two surveys, but new questions are also expected to arise, thus, the Privacy Survey that will be conducted now will differ from the project done before.
May we know the specifications for the respondents for this conduct of Privacy Survey?	The end-user is yet to review and finalize who the target respondents will be, such determination is intended to be made with the winning bidder and the other divisions of the National Privacy Commission who will contribute to the survey questions.
Will the result of the previous survey conducted be provided?	Yes, previous survey result will be provided to the winning bidder for the latter to have an insight as to what is expected from them.

Are there any segments of interest for the survey (particular area, age segment etc.)?	The end-user is yet to review and finalize if there will be any segment of interest, such determination is intended to be made with the winning bidder and the other divisions of the National Privacy Commission who will contribute to the survey questions.
Will there be a prescribed format for the data/report deliverable?	The end-user is yet to determine what will be the prescribed format for the data/re-port that the provider is expected to deliver, such determination is intended to be made with the winning bidder during the project briefing stage.
Are there any other requirements the bidders need to submit aside from those listed in the Bidding Documents?	Aside from those mentioned in the Bidding Documents, bidders are also reminded to comply with Government Procurement Policy Board Resolution No. 16-2020 approving Circular 04-2020 (Guidelines in the Preparation of the Simplified Philippine Bidding Documents for Goods and Infrastructure Projects and the Submission of the Required Forms to be included in the Procurement of Goods, Infrastructure Projects, and Consulting Services) issued on 16 September 2020. As such, bidders are reminded to submit the revised Bid Securing Declaration and Omnibus Sworn Statement, among others, as can be found in:

The foregoing shall form an integral part of the **Bidding Documents for the Conduct of Privacy Survey** for the National Privacy Commission. Any provision inconsistent herewith is hereby amended and superseded accordingly.
