	For the procurement of Non-expendable Supplies and Services: The Bidder must have completed a single contract that is similar to this Project, equivalent to at least fifty percent (50%) of the ABC.

Yes, the bidders need to attach the end user's acceptance or official receipt(s) or sales invoice issued for the contract, if completed as required by GPPB Circular 04-2020.
How many copies of the technical and financial proposal are the bidders required to submit?	Kindly submit one (1) original and five (5) copies of the technical and financial proposal.
