TECHNICAL SPECIFICATION

CENTRAL DATA REPOSITORY BUNDLED WITH ENCRYPTION HARDWARE
(APP Item No. 2021 - 0246)

I. BACKGROUND & OBJECTIVES

Background:

The National Privacy Commission (NPC) is committed to foster and lead the country at the forefront of personal information and data security in faithful keeping of its sacred mandate to safeguard the confidentiality, integrity, and security of personal data in the Philippines. In pursuit of this objective, one of the needed Information Technology (IT) infrastructure for good data governance is maintaining an on premises data repository where sensitive or confidential information of the Commission are kept and secured from unauthorized access.

The CDR processes data like a Storage Area Network (SAN) whereby a stack of storage devices or digital tools is shared to select and authorized offices in the NPC through a high-speed intranet, for real-time data access, storage, and retrieval. This will in turn enable the NPC to treat the abovementioned CDR as a single collective resource that can be centrally replicated and protected through encryption, especially for sensitive data handled by the NPC.

Objectives:

1. To migrate NPC's sensitive data residing in the end-user devices and cloud storage to the CDR;
2. To protect NPC data in mission-critical information systems, database, and network services;
3. To serve as support in NPC initiatives and ICT undertakings under the NPC ISSP the need for reliable and secured data storage is elementary;
4. To observe compliance with data security industry standards and best practices.

II. SCOPE OF THE PROJECT

The project scope shall include supply/delivery of a CDR with hardware encryption solution to protect stored data.

Supply and delivery of **CDR** bundled with encryption hardware;

1. Document all systems and provide documentation to the NPC
2. All equipment should be brand new and cover three (3) years service, software and hardware warranty

III. CONTRACTOR QUALIFICATIONS

1. Must be registered with the Securities and Exchange Commission for corporations or with the Department of Trade and Industry for Sole proprietorships/partnerships;
2. Supplier and its team involved with the project shall sign a notarized confidentiality and non-disclosure agreement;
3. Supplier must be philgeps registered;
4. Submit detailed proposal containing the following:
 - a. Product/solutions brochure with product specifications;
 - b. Schedule of delivery and
 - c. Supplier's warranty

IV. TECHNICAL SPECIFICATION

A. Data Repository Hardware :

1. Product must have at least **1TB** of *Solid State Drive (SSD)* storage;
2. Support versatile operating system preferably developed 2020 onwards;
3. Capable of local backup and replication to the cloud;
4. Versatile storage virtualization capabilities;
5. Solution write cache must be mirrored for highest data integrity and availability;
6. Must be able to support fibre channel (FC), network file system (NFS), Server Message Block (SMB)/Common Internet File System (OFS) (including SMB 2.0) and internet Small Computer System Interface (iSCSI) protocols; must have at least 2 USB ports
7. Will accommodate file level *encipherment* activities by other parties without affecting core systems performance;
8. Must have built-in virtualization capabilities and/or
9. Must support de-duplication and compression and/or
10. Must be protected against disk drive error and failure by enhanced RAID technologies and dynamic scrubbing and sparing and/or
11. Must be capable of replicating data from the primary to the secondary site for all internal storage as well as its virtualized storage and / or

12. Capability for checking and monitoring data space and encryption program and with the following minimum standards:
 - a. Processing Chip:
 - i. 8 core CPU
 - ii. 8 core GPU
 - iii. 16 core neural engines
 - b. Memory: 8GB to 16GB unified memory
 - c. Storage: at least 1TB SSD
 - d. Ports: thunderbolt 3, Gigabit Ethernet, HDMI 2.0, USB-A, 3.5mm headphone jack
 - e. Unified Architecture Memory must be able to access the same data with no need to swap between multiple sources of memory;
 - f. Product offered must have at least a 7430 multicore score in *geekbench* browser.
 - g. Access to repository is touch ID supported and/or capable;
 - h. Must come with at least 20" display monitor; capable of attaching second display unit;

B. Encryption Hardware

1. AES data encryption solely committed for line speed encryption and /or;
2. Compatible with the proposed CDR;
3. Must possess secure enclave with Touch ID management capabilities and storage controller with AES encryption hardware. Presence of 1 or 2 of these standards and protocols
Symmetrical encryption: AES 128 bit, AES 256 bit, XTS-AES 128 bit, XTS-AES 256 bit
Asymmetrical encryption: RSA (PKCS#1)
Hash functions: SHA-1, SHA-256, SHA-384, SHA-512
Password hashing: PKCS #5
Protocols and interfaces: PKCS #11, PKCS #15, LDAP, Microsoft Cryptographic Service Provider (CSP), SOAP, XML, SSL, TCG, CCID, Kerberos
PKI: PKCS #7, PKCS #12, X.509 Certificates

C. Warranty, Support and Documentation

1. Provider must be able to provide customer support, via 24/7 live chat and email for the end-user for *three (3)* years;
2. Product must have documentation available online;
3. Must provide reference or links to documents such as manual of operations, worksheets, or a wiki/knowledge management web resource or product details and/or manual *Manufacturers Brochure*
4. Product warranty and replacement for three (3) years. Supplier to issue certificate for three (3) year product and service warranty for 3 years.

Service Level Agreement

1. Technical support assistance must respond via telephone or email to resolve Data Encryption technical issues encountered, in which case severity levels are indicated below:
 - a. Severity Level 1 categorized as Minor - the issue must be resolved within one (1) hour after initial report to the service desk or customer support.
 - b. Severity Level 2 categorized as Major - the issue must be resolved at the soonest possible time (within 2 hours).
 - c. Severity Level 3 categorized as Critical - the issue must be resolved immediately (within 4 hours).

Delivery shall be consistent with the following schedule of requirements:


