BAC Resolution No. 010-2023, Series of 2023

RECOMMENDING THE APPROVAL OF THE EXTENSION OF CONTRACT FOR TELEPHONE-LANDLINE

WHEREAS, the National Privacy Commission (NPC) is the agency mandated to enforce data privacy protection;

WHEREAS, telephone-landline service is essential, indispensable, and necessary for the daily operations of the offices of the Commission, so as not to disrupt the provision of public services;

WHEREAS, the NPC has an existing contract with PLDT Inc. with a total contract amount of Php 464,743.44, inclusive of VAT, from 1 April 2022 to 31 December 2022;

WHEREAS, the procurement of Telephone-Landline for CY 2023 is still on-going and is expected to be completed beyond 31 December 2022;

WHEREAS, in view of the foregoing, the Administrative Services Division (ASD), the enduser, requested for the extension of the existing contract under the same terms and conditions of the original contract, in order to ensure continuity in the provision of telephone-landline services while the procurement of the regular contract is still being undertaken;

WHEREAS, Section 4.0 of Appendix 24 (Revised Guidelines on the Extension of Contracts for General Support Services) of the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of R.A. 9184 provides that procuring entities may extend the duration or effectivity of an ongoing contract about to expire, provided it complies with the conditions stated therein;

WHEREAS, the NPC Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) in BAC Resolution No. 162-2022, Series of 2022, recommended the approval of the extension of contract for Telephone-Landline from January 1 to 31, 2023 for a contract cost of Php 52,000.00;

WHEREAS, this extension was later on approved by the Head of the Procuring Entity;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Appendix 24, the ASD saw it fit to request an extension of the contract of NPC's current telephone-landline services to PLDT Inc., with the extension covering the period from 01 February 2023 to 28 February 2023 for a contract cost of Fifty-Two Thousand Pesos (Php52,000.00);

WHEREAS, the procurement of Telephone-Landline for CY 2023 is still on-going and is expected to be completed beyond 31 January 2023;

WHEREAS, this procurement has a Certification of Availability of Funds (CAF) with an Approved Budget for the Contract of Fifty-Two Thousand Pesos (Php52,000.00) chargeable against Telephone Expenses-Landline (GAS-MOOE) under the General Appropriations Act FY 2022 (RA 11639), programmed in the Work and Financial Plan (WFP) of ASD;

WHEREAS, the NPC has substantially undertaken the procurement activities required prior to award of the new contract and the extension of the original contract is merely an emergency measure to maintain status quo in the operations of the NPC;

WHEREAS, the current service provider has not violated any of the provisions of the original contract, with the end-user evaluating the performance of the current service provider, and finding the same to be acceptable, having mostly met the expectations of the end-user, a copy of the Certification of Satisfactory Performance is herein attached as Annex "A";

WHEREAS, the supplier, through its Assistant Vice-President, Mr. William N. Batac, expressed its conformity to the requested extension;

WHEREAS, the terms and conditions of the original contract shall apply during the extension period of the contract for Telephone-Landline;

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing, WE, the members of the NPC-BAC, hereby RESOLVE, as it is hereby RESOLVED, to recommend the extension of the contract for **Telephone-Landline** entered into with **PLDT Inc.** from **01 February 2023 to 28 February 2023**, with a total contract cost of Fifty-Two Thousand Pesos (Php52,000.00), subject to compliance to all relevant provisions of R.A. 9184 and its Revised IRR.

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EXTENSION OF CONTRACT FOR TELEPHONE-LANDLINE

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This EXTENSION OF CONTRACT is made and entered into this <u>31 January 2023</u>, in Metro Manila, Philippines, by and between:

The NATIONAL PRIVACY COMMISSION, a government agency mandated to administer and implement the Data Privacy Act of 2012, and to monitor and ensure compliance of the country with international standards set for data protection, with office address at the 5th Floor Delegation Building PICC Complex, Roxas Blvd, Pasay, Metro Manila, represented herein by its Privacy Commissioner, ATTY. JOHN HENRY D. NAGA, hereinafter referred to as the "NPC";

- and -

The PLDT, INC., a corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of Philippine laws, with principal office at Ramon Cojuangco Building, Makati Ave., Makati City, herein represented by its Assistant Vice President, WILLIAM N. BATAC (hereinafter referred to as the "SERVICE PROVIDER");

The NPC and the SERVICE PROVIDER shall hereinafter be referred to collectively as the "PARTIES."

WITNESSETH, that:

WHEREAS, the NPC and the SERVICE PROVIDER, pursuant to NPC Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) Resolution No. 013-2022, series of 2022, entered into a Telephone-Landline Renewal Agreement on 1 April 2022 which was in force and effect until 31 December 2022. A copy of said Agreement is attached herein as "ANNEX A" and made an integral part of this Extension of Contract;

WHEREAS, the NPC and the Service Provider, pursuant to NPC Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) Resolution No. 162-2022, series of 2022, entered into a Telephone-Landline extension Agreement on 29 December 2022 which was in force and effect on 1 January 2023 until 31 January 2023.

WHEREAS, on 30 January 2023 the NPC Accountant issued Certificate of Availability of Funds (CAF) amounting to Fifty Two Thousand Pesos (PHP52,000.00). A Copy of the CAF is hereto attached as Annex "B" and made an integral part of this Agreement.

WHEREAS, Section 4.0 of Appendix 24 (Revised Guidelines on the Extension of Contracts for General Support Services), of the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of R.A. 9184, provides that procuring entities may extend the duration or effectivity of an ongoing contract about to expire, provided it complies with the conditions stated therein;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Appendix 24, the ASD saw it fit to request the extension of the original contract of its current telephone-landline services to PLDT Inc., with the extension covering the period from 01 February 2023 to 31 February 2023 or until the award of new contract is completed, whichever comes first.

WHEREAS, on 30 January 2023, the NPC BAC deliberated on and resolved to approve the request of the end-user for extension of aforementioned Telephone-Landline Renewal Agreement from 1 February 2023 to 28 February 2023 as an emergency measure, given that the services rendered by the SERVICE PROVIDER are essential, indispensable, and necessary for the daily

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operation of the NPC, and that the extension of the contract with the **SERVICE PROVIDER** is vital.

WHEREAS, the terms and conditions of the Telephone-Landline Renewal Agreement dated 1 April 2022 shall be read and construed as part of this Agreement, and all terms and conditions of the Original Contract which are not inconsistent with this Agreement shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect;

WHEREAS, except when subsequently supplemented and amended by the PARTIES, all other terms and conditions set forth in the Telephone-Landline Renewal Agreement shall remain in full force and effect;

WHEREAS, the following modifications is hereby adopted which redounds to the advantage of the government at no additional cost to the NPC:

NPC may immediately terminate this Telephone – Landline Renewal Agreement upon service and delivery of a notice of the termination to the SERVICE PROVIDER on any of the following grounds: (1) failure to perform or materially breach, any of its obligations, covenants, or representations as set forth in the Telephone-Landline Agreement; (2) failure to produce a result that meets the specifications of provided for in the Telephone-Landline Agreement; and, (3) when the failure or breach is serious enough to materially harm or otherwise reduce the value of the Telephone-Landline Agreement.

In the event of termination, payment of the contract price will be made to the SERVICE PROVIDER only for the services provided up to the date of termination.

NPC shall pay the Service Provider a monthly rate of Fifty-Two Thousand Pesos (PHP52,000.00) inclusive of all applicable taxes.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, the **PARTIES** hereby agree to extend aforementioned Telephone-Landline Renewal Agreement from 1 February to 28 February 2023.
